Beyond Beauty ASEAN Bangkok 2016 (BBAB 2016) was officially opened on 22nd September 2016 at Challenger 3, IMPACT Exhibition & Convention Center, Bangkok, Thailand through the joint efforts of both the government and private sectors.

The 3-day trade exhibition attracted more than 12,358 trade visitors from 72 countries such as China, England, France, Germany, India, Italy, Japan, Korea, Kuwait, Singapore, Spain, United Arab Emirates, United States of America and many more. Paralleling with the exhibition were the BBAB Trends Conference, Aesthetics & Dermatology Congress, In-Fash Conference and many more workshops & seminars which saw the participation of more than 30 professional renowned international industry speakers who provided great insight into a variety of key industry topics.
